A very warm welcome to Birkacre Class (Year 4). Over the next week the children will be familiarising themselves with the rules and routines of Birkacre class. Next week, year 4 work begins!

This half term in Birkacre class we are exploring the topic of 'A night at the Movies' through the book *The Hobbit*. We are going to find out about J.R.R. Tolkien and what life in Britain was like at the time he wrote the *Hobbit*. We are going to write Riddles, Character descriptions, diaries and journals, as well as writing our own story about a journey and adventure. Through different media we will make and create woodland creatures. We will become familiar with our new maths scheme – Maths, No problem. The Autumn term begins with exploration of number, counting and place value.
