

**Homework:** Children are to complete 3 or more pieces of homework by Friday 31st March 2017. Please write in pen or pencil (not felt tip) using lined paper if necessary. If you have no lined paper we can provide you with some at school. Thanks, Mr.Roden.

After learning some names of common household ingredients in French at school and, if necessary with a little help from Google translate, create a list of the ingredients for your favourite recipe in French. We will be looking at colour and mixing colours to create different shades as part of our art topic this half term. Find a painting that inspires you and has a mixture of colour and shades in it. What type of paint has been used do you think? Create your own art book or gallery describing:

- The piece.
- Why you like it.
- Who the artist is and some information about them.

Listen to some music that your parents or relatives find mystical and enchanting. We will be listening to some in music at school this half term. Create a piece of writing that includes:

- The name of the track/youtube video.
- Any instruments you can hear.
- If you like it or not and why?

Be prepared to share with the class.

Write an interesting description of a setting which is familiar to you e.g. an average home, a street, a hospital, a school. Because the setting is familiar, you need to use clever descriptive techniques to give detail and make it sound interesting...otherwise it may be a little boring!
