




HOMework GRID



This term we are going to be learning about the Ancient Greeks. We will be creating Greek artefacts, trying Greek foods and much, much more! In Science, we will be looking at the circulatory system and thinking about how exercise benefits this. The activities marked with a ★ **must** be completed but all the others are a free choice as long as 3 out of the 8 are done before 3rd February.

Please don't feel as though they need to all be done in one week, they can be handed in as and when you have time but equally try not to leave them all to the last minute as I would love to show off your hard work on our Ancient Greeks class display!

<p>Carry out some exercise (long walk, bike ride, football etc.)</p> <p>Think about what happens to your body? How do you feel? Record your ideas. Could you keep a diary of this over a few weeks? Does anything change?</p> <p>Up to 10hps</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★</p>	<p>Find out about modern day Greece. Research the climate, food, culture.</p> <p>Create a tourist guide for someone travelling to Greece <u>or</u> imagine you are visiting Greece and are writing a postcard to send home.</p> <p>Up to 10hps</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★</p>	<p>FREE CHOICE –</p> <p>Make anything to do with Ancient Greece that interests you. This may be a Spartan warrior helmet, a temple, masks of the theatre...anything you like!</p> <p>Up to 20 hps</p>	<p>Research Greek pottery – can you create your own Greek pot or create a design for one?</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Up to 20hps</p>
<p>The Greeks were famous for starting the Olympics. Research an Olympian that you admire and write a biography of them – remember to hook the reader in, 3rd person, vary noun phrase, include key dates and events.</p> <p>Up to 10hps</p> <p style="text-align: right;">★</p>	<p>Write a newspaper report about the first ever Olympics. Where was it? What happened? Did you speak to an eye-witness? Remember to include - intro (5 w's), quotes, past tense, 3rd person, time connectives, chronological order.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Up to 10hps</p>	<p>Research the circulatory system – could you create a model, image or poster to explain how this works?</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Up to 20hps</p>	<p>Imagine the Spartan warriors (savage, terrifying Greek armies) were about to invade your village. Write a letter to the chief commander persuading them not to. Remember to be persuasive – emotive language, signpost openers, imperative verbs, direct to reader.</p> <p>Up to 10hps</p>
