## PARENT'S EVENING

Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> October from 2.30 - 6.00pm

We will again be using a 'Parents Evening App' through our Teacher's 2 Parent's text messaging service to make appointments. A text message has been sent out today inviting you to the Parent's Evening along with a web link. By clicking this link on either a smart phone or using a computer, you will be taken to a log in page where you will be prompted to enter your child's name. If you have more than one child in school, all of your children's names should appear with the option to make a 5 minute appointment with each class teacher.

If you have any difficulties or do not own or have access to a computer, please come to the office to make an appointment.

We hope that this new system will make the process more efficient and easier for everybody, allowing you to book the best appointment time to fit your schedule.

All appointments with class teachers will take place in the hall and class rooms will be open for you to look at your child's work. We would please ask that you do not bring children with you as there will be no one to supervise them.

## MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS

Where possible, we ask that all medical appointments be made out of school hours. However we understand that this is sometimes unavoidable.

If your child requires any time off school, for a medical appointment, please give school as much notice as possible. We also ask that you bring a copy of your child's appointment letter/card into the office so we are able to take a copy for our records.

## CAR PARK - URGENT REQUEST - PLEASE READ
