


# HOMWORK GRID

This half term our whole school topic will be 'A Night at the Movies'. Please choose 4 of the activities that are listed below but don't forget that the ones marked with a ★ **must** be done. Please try to get into the good habits of doing one a week so that you are not trying to rush it all at the end. Homework is a chance for you to get extra practice at things we have looked at in class or just a chance to be creative and have some fun with our topic, however just because it is done at home doesn't mean it should be messy or rushed. If it isn't to the standard that is expected in class then it won't get the full amount of house points. Each activity is worth different amounts of house points which all add up to non-uniform days each half term and this year the winners went to the cinema at the end of the year. With this in mind you can do more than 4 activities so that you can earn more house points. Please make sure that any homework you plan to do is handed in by **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October** – you have plenty of time.

<p>Watch any film you want and complete the movie review sheet. Remember that a review is supposed to help someone decide if they want to watch the film or not so make sure you give enough detail.</p> <p>5hp</p>	<p>In your homework book write a description of your favourite movie character. We will be learning how to do this properly during the half term so you might want to wait until we have learnt about it in class.</p> <p>5hp ★</p>	<p>Make a collage of all of your favourite film stars or characters. Find pictures of them in magazines, newspapers, comics or online. Cut them out and stick them to the movie character sheet.</p> <p>5hp</p>	<p>Can the grown-ups at home add and subtract like you can? See if you can explain how we add and subtract to a grown up at home. Get them to write a note in your homework book if they understood how to do it. Wait until we have taught the Year 3 way of doing it before you try this.</p> <p>5hp ★</p>
<p>Make a game based on a film. You might make noughts and crosses or a nerf gun game. Have a go at designing a cage to trap a dragon. (You don't have to build the cage just draw what it would look like and make a note of what it would be made of).</p> <p>5hp</p>	<p>Make a Harry Potter movie poster. Have a look online for some ideas of what you might want it to look like. Please don't just copy an existing poster though.</p> <p>5hp</p>
