



## Core Subjects Overview Year Five Autumn 2018

# Creative Curriculum Overview Year 4 Autumn 1

## Creative Curriculum Overview Year 4 Autumn 2

### Art:

Explore, plan and create emotive pieces of artwork to portray their feelings about WW2. Also different sketching and pencil techniques to draw accurate pictures of WW2 aircrafts

### DT:

Children will create their own WW2 meal using rationing. Create design and make their own gas masks and carry boxes.

### Computing:

Children will learn coding skills before designing their own morse code after exploring ways of decoding it and using it to communicate.

### Science:

Electricity - children will create their own circuits, switches and list conductors and insulators after investigation. Make an alarm.
