


STAR WARS Homework Grid

Can you create your own artwork in a Pop Art style?</p>  <p>Up to 20hps (Art)</p>	<p>Choose a location around the world (e.g. desert, ice, jungle). Design a new animal that is adapted to survive in that environment.</p>  <p>Up to 20hps (Science)</p>
<p>Choose your favourite song/score/soundtrack to a movie. Describe why it is your favourite soundtrack. How does it make you feel? What instruments have been used in it?
